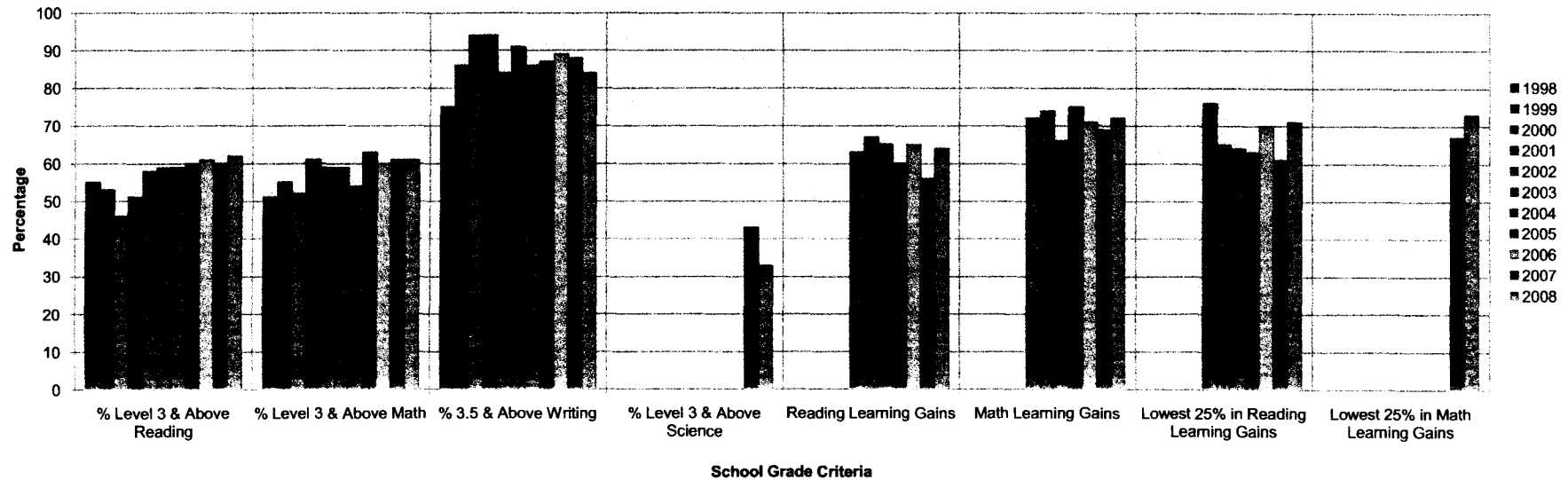

² Beginning 2005, the criterion for meeting high standards in Writing will rise from % 3.0 + 3.5 & Above to the % 3.5 & Above. In addition, learning gains calculations will include students from all curriculum groups.

³ Beginning 2007, the formula will include the percentage of students scoring in Achievement Level 3 and above on FCAT Science and the percentage of students in the lowest quartile on FCAT-SSS Math making learning gains.
